

Guidelines for Students on Second Baptist Church Mission Trip

Dress Code

- Shorts are to be no shorter than fingertips extended all the way down the side.
- When swimming, girls are not to wear two-piece swimsuits. If they do, they should wear a dark colored shirt over it.
- Shirts are to be modest. No midriffs. If sleeveless, there should not be an undergarment showing. If v-neck, it should be high enough to not be revealing.

Drugs, Alcohol, and Tobacco

- These substances will not be allowed. If caught with them, the student will be sent home at the expense of his or her parents *on the first offense*.

Electronics

- No cell phones are allowed. The adult sponsors will have cell phones to use in case of emergency.
- Music players may be brought. Only Christian music is allowed. There will be random checks of music throughout the trip. No mp3 should have secular music stored on it.

Public Display of Affection

- No student should lay or sit in another student's lap.
- No two students should share a blanket.

Consequences

1. An adult will discuss the occurrence with the student on the first offense.
2. On the second offense or if there is no response on the first offense, the youth minister and the student will call the student's parent.
3. On the third offense, the student will be sent home at the expense of his or her parent.
